


Silverstone GP & English ride (Aug 6–10)



From Aug 6 to 10, departing from Calais, Caribou Travel takes you on a **motorbike ride** through the **English countryside**, via the coast, **Rye**, **Bodiam Castle**, the cliffs of **Beachy Head**, **Brighton**, **South Downs National Park**, then **Oxford**. Next, head to **Silverstone**, where you'll attend the **British MotoGP!** Two options: '**Classic**', with a guided ride in the **Cotswolds** on Saturday and GP entry on Sunday; or '**MotoGP Experience**', with an all-in program on Saturday and Sunday including e.g. paddock access and the Fantic team garage, **Meet & Greet with Barry Baltus**, plus open bar & restaurant! Return to Calais via the **Aston Martin Museum** and the iconic **Ace Cafe in London**. MotoGP Experience option in partnership with **Zelos**.



Thursday 6 August 2026

Welcome of participants late morning in Calais (hotel overnight possible the day before, optional).

Luggage transfer to the support van and briefing for participants.

Crossing via Le Shuttle / Eurotunnel.

Drive to Rye, one of England's most beautiful villages, the medieval Bodiam Castle, then Eastbourne (and its famous pier) and the impressive Beachy Head cliffs.

Then head to vibrant Brighton on the coast.

Check-in at the centrally located 4* hotel. Dinner included at the hotel (drinks not included). Paid parking.

Free evening in Brighton.

Friday 7 August 2026



Breakfast at the hotel (included).

Briefing for participants.

Drive to South Downs National Park, then Winchester (former royal capital with its magnificent cathedral), the North Wessex Downs (a National Landscape), before reaching Oxford, the famous university city (one of England's most beautiful).

Short drive to Bicester, our base camp located 30 minutes from Silverstone Circuit.

Check-in at the 4* hotel (set apart, in a golf resort). Free parking.

Dinner included at the hotel (drinks not included).

Free evening. The hotel has a spa (treatments at extra cost) and an indoor pool.



Saturday 8 August 2026

Breakfast at the hotel (included) and briefing for participants.

'Classic' package

Guided ride discovering the splendid Cotswolds region, with postcard villages such as Bourton-on-the-Water, Bibury, Burford, Stow, Castle Combe or Broadway (about 270 km).

'MotoGP Experience' package

Direct route to Silverstone (about 31 km). MotoGP Experience: VIP Paddock Pass, exclusive access to the MotoGP paddock all weekend, access to hospitality with refreshments and lunch, open bar & restaurant, guided paddock tour and Fantic garage, meet & greet with Barry Baltus, trackside access at different moments of the weekend, grandstand seats in a 'viewing area', personalized support by the Zelos team. Direct route back to Bicester (about 31 km).

Dinner not included. Free evening. Overnight in Bicester.



Sunday 9 August 2026

Breakfast at the hotel (included) and briefing for participants. Direct route to Silverstone (about 31 km).

'Classic' package

Admission ticket to attend the MotoGP British Grand Prix (grandstand to be specified).

'MotoGP Experience' package

MotoGP Experience: VIP Paddock Pass, exclusive access to the MotoGP paddock all weekend, access to hospitality with refreshments and lunch, open bar & restaurant, guided paddock tour and Fantic garage, meet & greet with Barry Baltus, trackside access at different moments of the weekend, grandstand seats in a 'viewing area', personalized support by the Zelos team.

Direct route back to Bicester (about 31 km). Dinner not included. Free evening. Overnight in Bicester.



Monday 10 August 2026

Breakfast at the hotel (included). Briefing for participants.

Drive to the Aston Martin Heritage Trust, a superb museum dedicated to the brand (visit at extra cost), then the pretty town of Henley-on-Thames on the Thames.

Head to the iconic Ace Cafe on the outskirts of London, near Wembley and the Notting Hill area.

After a break in this legendary place of pilgrimage, direct drive to Folkestone.

Crossing via Le Shuttle late afternoon.

Arrival in Calais expected early evening. Drive back to the meeting point in Calais (overnight possible, optional). Luggage handover.
