Day 1


Arrival at Halifax Airport. Pick up rental car and transfer to downtown Halifax. Overnight in hotel.



Day 2

Visit Halifax, both modern and historic, located on a natural harbour. Discover maritime heritage, museums and historic houses. Optional whale-watching cruise.

Overnight at the same hotel.



Day 3

Drive to Peggy's Cove, picturesque fishing village with famous lighthouse. Continue via Lighthouse Road to Western Shore.

Overnight in hotel.

Day 4



Visit Lunenburg and the Fisheries Museum. Continue inland through forests and lakes. Explore Kejimkujik National Park. Arrival in Annapolis Basin.

Day 5

Digby is famous for scallop fishing. Optional excursion to Brier Island for a 4-hour whale-watching cruise in the Bay of Fundy.

Overnight at the same location.



Day 6

Drive through Annapolis Valley along the Evangeline Trail. Discover Acadian history sites including Fort Edward and Grand-Pré. Continue along the Glooscap Trail with the world's highest tides.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 7

Drive toward Port-Elgin and cross the Confederation Bridge to Prince Edward Island. Continue to Charlottetown.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 8

Explore charming Charlottetown with its Victorian houses. Optional lobster fishing cruise or visit Prince Edward Island National Park.

Overnight at the same hotel.



Day 9

Ferry from Wood Islands to Nova Scotia. Continue to Antigonish via scenic Sunrise Trail.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 10

Drive to Cape Breton Island via Baddeck and visit Alexander Graham Bell Historic Site. Continue along Cabot Trail to Cheticamp.

Overnight in oceanfront motel.



Day 11

Drive the spectacular Cabot Trail along Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Wildlife viewing possible.

Overnight in Ingonish.



Day 12

Continue along Cabot Trail to Sydney, major port city of Nova Scotia.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 13

Drive Marconi Trail to Louisbourg Fortress, major historical reconstruction site. Continue along Bras d'Or Lake to West Bay.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 14

Drive Marine Drive to Liscomb Mills. Optional stops at Canso Islands and Sherbrooke Village.

Overnight in hotel.



Day 15

Continue Marine Drive back to Halifax.

Overnight in hotel.

Morning to discover other aspects of the city. Departure in the afternoon for the airport. Return of the car and boarding for your flight home.
